Steve Loeffler WB9ZRE reported at this past Saturday's club meeting that sometime between last Saturday evening and Thursday afternoon (March 9 to March 14, 2024) one or more individuals broke into a hot air balloon trailer located in the fenced back storage lot of Choices Wholesale Flooring Solutions, 4382 Alexander Blvd NE, Albuquerque, NM 87107 (approximately 1000 feet west-southwest of the Topgolf facility at I-25 & Montaño/Montgomery exit).

In addition to unique "Dawn's Delight" branded ballooning shirts, hats, and blankets, the thief/thieves also stole the following electronics:

- 2 sets Flytec 3040 flight instruments (s/n 10668 & 10546) and the TT34 temperature sensors (s/n 5880 & 5888),
- 2 Icom aircraft handheld radios (IC-A16, IC-A24)
- 2 Baofeng UV-82c (commercial version) handheld radios

- 2 Baofeng UV-5RT handheld radios & chargers (s/n: 135T020295 & 135T020329)

All radios in cordura molle radio pouches (black, tan, or camo). All radios have Owner name & phone number labels between the radio and removable battery and bottoms of each radio and battery. All Baofeng radios software branded with "Dale Ruth" or "Kyle Ruth" displayed during boot-up on LCD display].

All Baofeng radios were Tx/Rx simplex programmed with 8 Amateur Radio frequencies, all 22 GMRS frequencies, 6 marine band frequencies, 11 Balloon Fiesta pilot/crew/official's frequencies, 2 Search & Rescue frequencies, and 3 NOAA weather frequencies (RX only).
